






#4 Where do you live?




Where are you studying?



Are you enrolled full-time or part-time?




Which mode of study are you currently enrolled in?



Do you believe Australian universities are providing the right courses and degrees to develop the new skills required in the future workforce of Australia?




Rank in order the top 3 reasons you chose to attend the university you are currently enrolled at?







How would you describe your enrolment experience with your university?




How important is it for you to be able to self-manage your enrolment and administrative experience online?



How would you summarise the use of technology innovation in your course?




How important is your ability to access course resources and materials from anywhere, at any time, from any device (phone, tablet, PC, smart TV, etc)?




How important is a consistent student experience across all course touchpoints/interactions?




Would you switch to a different university to use better levels of technology and innovation?
